The **Certified Federal Contracts Manager (CFCM)** certification validates your education, training, experience, and knowledge of the *Federal Acquisition Regulation*.



The **Certified Commercial Contracts Manager (CCCM)** certification validates your education, training, experience, and knowledge of the *Uniform Commercial Code*.
